D.	Public Forum (Community members will be given a few minutes each to share their concerns, ideas, celebrations, etc.) • Eric Posern shared that he received information regarding student cell phone use. He reviewed policies related to electronic devices and cell phones from the 2023-2024 CSISD Student Handbook. He also shared policies from two high-performing school districts in Texas, based on SAT scores and athletic championships. He would like CSISD to look at and consider its policies to improve the day-to-day learning environment for our students. Kevin Starnes acknowledged that cell phones can be distracting, but they are also a tool for learning. He shared that this conversation could continue in the future.

	 Neo Jang shared information from the B/CS Metropolitan Planning Organization. They are working to improve transportation network safety by reducing or eliminating roadway fatalities and serious injuries. They are requesting feedback via a survey at: https://engagekh.com/bcssafety/map#/ This survey is open to everyone in Brazos County. The plan is for the steering committee to apply for a federal grant from Safe Streets for All and address as many concerns as possible.
E.	 Safety Update Tracee McClendon, Coordinator of Safety & Risk Management, provided an in-depth overview of school safety. She discussed our CSISD School Safety & Security Committee, multi-hazard emergency operations plans, emergency drills, emergency communication, safety audits, and TEA school safety standards.
F.	 Wellness Plan Subcommittee Kevin Starnes provided an update on the Wellness Plan Assessment. Magan Smith provided an overview of the WellSAT 3.0. The Wellness Plan Assessment will be available on the SHAC website and presented to the Board of Trustees at the April school board meeting.
