
College Station ISD Summer School Course Description Guide 2020

For all courses “A” indicates the fall semester of the course. “B” indicates the spring semester of the course. Most courses are self-paced, meaning if a student is motivated and completes work in a timely fashion it may not take all of June to complete a semester-long class. Students beginning a course will not receive a refund after June 12th.

Students may only enroll in one class at a time.

All courses are online using Edgenuity. Reading and submissions must be completed online from home, students must have internet access.

All original credit courses will have Zoom or Google Hangout proctored exams & final exams.

ENGLISH

English I A or B

Who can take this course: students who have previously failed English I

Prerequisite: previously taken English I and failed

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00 for each semester

This course is designed for remediation only. Students will work through online coursework with the assistance and supervision of a teacher. Work is self-paced and requires extensive reading and writing.

English II A or B

Who can take this course: students who have previously failed English II

Prerequisite: previously taken English II and failed

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00 for each semester

This course is designed for remediation only. Students will work through online coursework with the assistance and supervision of a teacher. Work is self-paced and requires extensive reading and writing.

English III A or B

Who can take this course: students who have failed the course previously or who would like to take it for original credit

Prerequisite: must be current high school student and need credit for English III A or B

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00 for each semester

Students will have extensive reading and studying online to prepare for the exams and final exam. A teacher will be available via Schoology. The teacher will also be monitoring student progress, student time spent working on modules, and submitting grades. Eras to be studied include: The Revolutionary War, Transcendentalism, Romanticism, Realism, Naturalism, Modernism, and more.

English IV A or B

Who can take this course: students who have failed the course previously or who would like to take it for original credit

Prerequisite: must be current high school student and need credit for English IV A or B

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00 for each semester

This course is designed for remediation or advancement. **Students will have extensive reading and studying online to prepare for the exams and final.** A teacher will be available via Schoology during the day to answer questions and assist students. The teacher will also be monitoring student progress, student time spent working on modules, and submitting grades. Literature covered includes: *Beowulf*, *The Canterbury Tales*, *Hamlet*, *The Importance of Being Earnest*, and more.

MATH

Algebra I A or B

Who can take this course: students who have previously failed Algebra I

Prerequisite: must be current high school student and have taken Algebra I and failed it

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00 for each semester

This course is for remediation only. Computer based modules will help students with mastery of Algebra I concepts. Focused effort is necessary for students to complete the work and earn credit. Students will complete a pre-test for each required unit and will only have to complete those units on which they have not shown mastery.

Algebra II A or B

Who can take this course: students who have previously failed Algebra II

Prerequisite: must be current high school student and have taken Algebra II and failed it

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00 for each semester

This course is for remediation only. Computer based modules will help students complete remediation of Algebra II concepts. Focused effort is necessary for students to complete the work and earn credit.

Geometry A or B

Who can take this course: students who have previously failed Geometry

Prerequisite: must be current high school student and have taken Geometry and failed it

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00 for each semester

This course is for remediation only. Computer based modules will help students with mastery of Geometry concepts. Focused effort is necessary for students to complete the work and earn credit. Students will complete a pre-test for each required unit and will only have to complete those units on which they have not shown mastery.

Algebraic Reasoning A or B

Who can take this course: students who have previously failed Algebraic Reasoning

Prerequisite: must be current high school student and have taken Algebraic Reasoning and failed it

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00 for each semester

Computer based modules will help students complete remediation of Algebraic Reasoning concepts. Focused effort is necessary for students to complete the work and earn credit.

SOCIAL STUDIES

World History A or B

Who can take this course: students who have failed the course previously or who would like to take it for original credit (including incoming freshmen)

Prerequisite: must be current high school student

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00 for each semester

Students will work under the daily support of a classroom teacher to complete this computer-based course.

Students will have extensive reading and studying online to prepare for the exams and final. A teacher will be available via Schoology during the day to answer questions and assist students. The teacher will also be monitoring student progress, student time spent working on modules, and submitting grades.

World Geography A or B

Who can take this course: students who have failed the course previously or who would like to take it for original credit (including incoming freshmen)

Prerequisite: must be current high school student

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00 for each semester

Students will work under the daily support of a classroom teacher to complete this computer-based course. Work is self-paced and requires extensive reading.

Students will have extensive reading and studying online to prepare for the exams and final. A teacher will be available via Schoology during the day to answer questions and assist students. The teacher will also be monitoring student progress, student time spent working on modules, and submitting grades. Content includes climate, physical and human geography, world geography, and current events.

U. S. History A or B

Prerequisite: Must be current high school student and have taken U.S. History and failed it

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00 for each semester

This course is designed for remediation only. Students will work through online coursework with the assistance and supervision of a teacher. Students will complete a pre-test for each required unit and will only have to complete those units on which they have not shown mastery. Work is self-paced and requires extensive reading. U. S. Government

Who can take this course: students who have failed the course previously or who would like to take it for original credit

Prerequisite: must be a current high school student

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00

This course is designed for advancement. **Students will have extensive reading and studying online to prepare for the exams and final.** A teacher will be available via Schoology during the day to answer questions and assist students. The teacher will also be monitoring student progress, student time spent working on modules, and submitting grades. Content includes the branches of government, federalism, local government and more.

Economics

Who can take this course: students who have failed the course previously or who would like to take it for original credit

Prerequisite: must be a current high school student

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00

This course is designed for remediation or advancement. Reading and submissions may be completed online from home at any time as long as the student has internet access. **Students will have extensive reading and studying online to prepare for the exams and final.** A teacher will be available via Schoology during the day to answer questions and assist students. The teacher will also be monitoring student progress, student time spent working on modules, and submitting grades.

SCIENCE

Introduction to Physics and Chemistry (IPC) A or B

Who can take this course: students who have previously failed IPC

Prerequisite: must be current high school student and have taken IPC and failed it

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00 for each semester

This course is for remediation only with no exceptions. Computer based modules will help students complete remediation of IPC concepts. Focused effort is necessary for students to complete the work and earn credit.

Biology A or B

Who can take this course: students who have previously failed Biology

Prerequisite: must be current high school student and have taken Biology and failed it

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00 for each semester

Biology A and B each have approximately 10 modules to complete plus the final exam. As with all of the courses completed by modules, work is self-paced and requires extensive reading.

Chemistry A or B

Who can take this course: students who have previously failed Chemistry

Prerequisite: must be current high school student and have taken Chemistry and failed it

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00 for each semester

Chemistry A and B each have approximately 10 modules to complete plus the final exam. As with all of the courses completed by modules, work is self-paced and requires extensive reading.

Environmental Systems A or B

Who can take this course: students who have never taken Environmental Systems and need original credit

Prerequisite: current high school student

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00

This course is designed for remediation or advancement. **Students will have extensive reading and studying online to prepare for the exams and final.** A teacher will be available via Schoology during the day to answer questions and assist students. The teacher will also be monitoring student progress, student time spent working on modules, and submitting grades.

HEALTH (Elective Credit Only)

Health

Who can take this course: students who have failed the course previously or who would like to take it for original credit (including incoming freshmen)

Prerequisite: none

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00

This course is designed for remediation or advancement. This course has approximately 28 lessons and 8 submissions. **Students will have extensive reading and studying online to prepare for the exams and final.** A teacher will be available via Schoology during the day to answer questions and assist students. The teacher will also be monitoring student progress, student time spent working on modules, and submitting grades. Content includes wellness, body systems, alcohol, drugs, tobacco, public health, first aid and more.

PE

Foundations of Personal Fitness

Who can take this course: students who have failed the course previously or who would like to take it for original credit (including incoming freshmen)

Prerequisite: none

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00

This course is designed for remediation or advancement. **Students will have extensive reading and studying online to prepare for the exams and final.** A teacher will be available via Schoology during the day to answer questions and assist students. The teacher will also be monitoring student progress, student time spent working on modules, and submitting grades. Content includes cardiovascular endurance, muscular endurance, muscular strength, flexibility, body fat percentage, agility, balance, and body composition.

SPEECH

Speech (Communication Applications)

Who can take this course: students who have failed the course previously or who would like to take it for original credit (including incoming freshmen)

Prerequisite: none

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00

Speech is a course which includes 10 modules plus the final exam. Students will be required to research and write their own speeches, as well as perform those speeches for the teacher. As with all of the courses completed by modules, work is self-paced and requires extensive reading.

Languages Other Than English

Spanish I A or B

Who can take this course: students who have failed the course previously or who would like to take it for original credit

Prerequisite: must be current high school student in need of Spanish I credit

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00

Attendance: No more than 3 absences allowed without permission from principal

This course contains necessary audio as well, so it is important to note that a sound feature should be enabled on the student's computer. **Students will have extensive reading and studying online to prepare for the exams and final.** A teacher will be available via Schoology during the day to answer questions and assist students. The teacher will also be monitoring student progress, student time spent working on modules, and submitting grades. Content includes vocabulary, interactive lessons, and auditory pronunciation.

Spanish II A or B

Who can take this course: students who have failed the course previously or who would like to take it for original credit

Prerequisite: Spanish I credit

Credit: 1/2

Fee: \$100.00

This course contains necessary audio as well, so it is important to note that a sound feature should be enabled on the student's computer. **Students will have extensive reading and studying online to prepare for the exams and final.** A teacher will be available via Schoology during the day to answer questions and assist students. The teacher will also be monitoring student progress, student time spent working on modules, and submitting grades. Content includes vocabulary, interactive lessons, and auditory pronunciation.

FINE ARTS

Art Appreciation A or B

Who can take this course: students who would like to take it for original credit

Prerequisite: none

Credit: 1/2 (must have one whole credit of the same fine arts course to count as a fine art credit)

Fee: \$100.00

Students will have extensive reading and studying online to prepare for the midterm and final exams. A teacher will be available via Schoology during the day to answer questions and assist students. The teacher will also be monitoring student progress, student time spent working on modules, and submitting grades. This course will consist of the analyzation of artwork. Students will be required to submit projects.
